The National Exhibition has been showcasing the best of works by camera club and Photographic Society of New Zealand members for over 60 years.







# NATURE PRINTS

The standard of the Nature Prints submitted this year was, in my opinion, superior to previous years. With the increased understanding people now have of their equipment and the current technology that they are using, it does not surprise me that the image quality is getting better each year.

Nature rules are quite strict and there are limited post-production adjustments that can be performed which makes capturing the subject

without distractions, showing the environment or a sense of scale even more challenging.

Of the 153 nature prints submitted, it was at times, a hard task to select only a portion for display as space was limited to only allow 70 to be displayed.

Even though the genre of nature has specific rules, the basics still apply. Composition, sharpness and appropriate cropping etc are important along with making sure you have the correct identification of the subject and named the image properly.

As a nature photographer, I notice there is a trend to not just show the subject posing in their environment, and photographers are now going to the effort to show how nature subjects interact with their environment or show a characteristic unique to them/it.

What was interesting this year was that there was a rather high percentage of bird images submitted, which made the selection harder to showcase the true variety of nature subjects.


